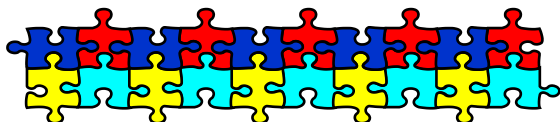

#### By Public Transportation

**BART:** Before exiting Daly City Station, get yellow ticket dispensed from the white machine in front of the gates for a free roundtrip ride on 28/28L MUNI bus lines. Take either line to 19th Ave./Holloway Ave.

**MUNI:** Take the M streetcar line or the 17, 18, 26, 28, 29 bus lines to the 19th Ave./Holloway Ave. stop.

#### By Car

**From the North:** Take highway 101 S, cross the Golden Gate Bridge, and exit at 19th Ave./Hwy 1. Follow 19th Ave. to Holloway Ave. to reach the campus.

**From the South:** Take I-280 N and exit at 19th Ave. Take Junipero Serra Blvd. to Holloway Ave. and turn left on Holloway Ave. to reach the campus.

**From the East:** Take I-80 across the Bay Bridge to 101 S. From 101 S, transfer to I-280, toward Daly City. Exit on Mission St./Daly City, bear right onto Sagamore St. to Brotherhood Way to Junipero Serra Blvd North. Follow Junipero Serra to Holloway Ave., and make a left on Holloway Ave. to campus at 19th Ave.

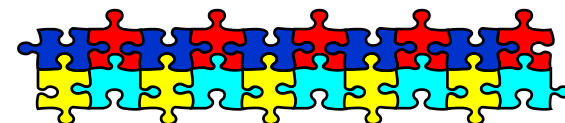
